

Top Tips for supporting your child's learning at home...

1. Use maths talk every day - Whenever you have the opportunity, try to include maths talk in their lives. This could be as simple as finding opportunities to count on journeys or handling money when shopping.
2. Play maths games together - Many games use mathematical and logical skills that your children will need in later life - plus they're fun!
