



Cherry Class Homework Menu

Our topic this half term is to continue with the Great Fire of London. Over the next seven weeks you need to complete one task each week and hand it in by Wednesday.

Please write the task at the top of your 'Home Learning Book' and then place your homework underneath it. Just a quick reminder homework must be completed to a good standard and presentation in homework books must be kept neat and tidy. Please take your time and treat it as you would treat work given to you in school.

English

- Can you read a story at home with your grown-up and write 5 sentences telling me all about it? The sentences need to include a capital letter, full stop, fingers spaces and you need to sound out each word using your phonics.
- Can you write a letter to Santa to tell him what you would like for Christmas? Remember to start words which are names with capital letters such as Lego.
- Write 6 or more sentences, using noun phrases, about something linked to bonfire night such as fireworks or something linked to Christmas such as a Christmas tree. For example, The **bright, red fireworks** exploded into the sky.

Maths

- With an adult, can you make something by measuring out the ingredients and following the recipe i.e. fruity cocktail, biscuits, cakes, bread, salads? Remember to send a picture and show us what you make!
- Practise your 5 times table until you know it off by heart, in order and mixed up i.e. $3 \times 5 = 15$, $5 \times 5 = 25$, $12 \times 5 = 60$.
- Can you make a right angle finder and then go on a right angle hunt around your house? How many can you find? What is the most unusual place you found one?

Topic

- Can you draw a picture of an animal and label it i.e. ears, claws, horns, wings. For a challenge, can you write a list of things your animal eats? Is it an herbivore, omnivore or a carnivore?
- Can you draw or paint a picture of the Great Fire of London. What do you think it would have looked like? What colours would you have seen?
- Can you create a circuit of activities in your garden? Time yourself to do them and then challenge an adult. Who can do it the fastest? Write a sentence in your book to tell us how long it took you and your adult to complete the circuit.
- Can you create a poster for Anti-bullying week? What do we need to tell people to do who are being bullied? What good information will you tell us?
