

Cherry Class Homework Menu

Our topic this term is 'Our Wonderful World/ Rights'. Over the next eight weeks you need to complete one task and the spelling each week and hand it in by Wednesday.

Please write the task at the top of your 'Home Learning Book' and then place your homework underneath it. Just a quick reminder homework must be completed to a good standard and presentation in homework books must be kept neat and tidy. Please take your time and treat it as you would treat work given to you in school.

English

- Can you go on a senses walk and write down 3 things that you see, hear, smell and touch? On your walk, were you able to taste anything?
- Write 5 sentences to describe your favourite place - where is it, why do you like it there, what does it look like there, why is it your favourite place?
- Can you write a shopping list using commas?
- Can you write an acrostic poem about something linked to Halloween? For example, witch, black cat, sweets, pumpkin, wizard, trick or treat etc.

Maths

- Practise recalling your number bonds to 20 i.e. $20+0=20$, $19+1=20$ and know them off by heart. Get a grown up to test you!
- Practise your 2 times table until you know it off by heart, in order and mixed up i.e. $3 \times 2 = 6$, $5 \times 2 = 10$, $12 \times 2 = 24$. This will help with our work in class.
- Can you use different colour paper to cut out different 2d shapes and stick them in your book to create something? For example a robot, a house, a train, a rocket etc.
- Can you choose 8 numbers and partition them into tens and ones i.e. $32 = 30 + 2$.

Topic

- Can you do some balancing at home - it could be on the floor or on equipment? What will you balance on - will it be your foot, bottom, back? Remember to take some pictures as we would love to see you and send them to me on class dojo!
- Can you research a 'Wonder of the World' and either create a replica, write some sentences about it or draw a picture and label it with an interesting fact?
- Can you go on a materials walk around your home/ outside and write me a list of objects you see and the materials they are made from i.e. spoon made of metal?
- Can you research Nelson Mandela, Emily Davison or Rosa Parks and write some facts to explain why they are important people from History? (Look on the BBC bitesize website to help you with this. There is some information and a video to watch).
