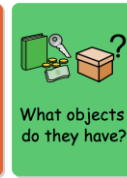


Autumn homework menu!

Our topic for Autumn term is Our Wonderful World, including standing up for what is right!

English activities

- ☐ Use our “Colourful Semantics” blocks to plan and write 5 or more super sentences. Think carefully about each part of your sentence and remember to use those little joining words like the, is, on etc.



- ☐ All of the grown-ups in Holly class love reading all different kinds of books and we love to share stories in the classroom. Can you recommend some of your favourite stories for us? Write us a mini book review to tell us a little bit about the story, who the main characters are, and why you loved that book so much.

- ☐ Mrs Evans loves Mr Men and Little Miss! ☺ Can you draw and colour a beautiful picture of your favourite Mr Man or Little Miss and then write some sentences underneath to describe them? Remember to use lots of amazing adjectives to describe their colour, size, shape, outfits etc.



Maths activities

- ☐ How many ways can you make 10? Count out 10 objects from home and practise putting them into different groups to see how many different ways you can find to make 10! For example, $9 + 1$ or $3 + 3 + 4$.

- ☐ Complete a 3D shape hunt at home. How many things can you find in your house that are shaped like a cube, a cuboid, a cylinder and a sphere? Can you find anything that is a less common 3D shape, like a pyramid or triangular prism? Write down as many things as you can in your homework book!



- ☐ Get your grown-up to write six 2-digit numbers in your homework book, like 29, 32, 47 etc. Using something you have at home like pasta pieces, buttons, Lego bricks, straws etc, count out the correct number of objects and then see how many groups of ten you can make. How many ones are left over? Can you record them in your book? e.g. $29 = 2$ groups of ten and 9 ones.

Topic activities – Our Wonderful World

- ☐ **Art task:** Miss Rogers' favourite season is autumn, and she loves to go for a walk on an autumn day, crunching through all the leaves that have fallen from the trees! Next time you go for a walk, collect some interesting leaves and sticks etc, and use them to make an autumn collage! You can use any craft things you have at home as well, or let us know if you need to borrow some from school! Please use a separate piece of paper rather than your homework book for this task, as we would love to display some in the classroom! Make sure to use plenty of glue so that the leaves don't fall off. We would love to see lots of different colours, like greens, orange, yellows, reds and browns ☺
- ☐ **Science task:** In Science, we are going to be learning all about different materials! Have a go at a material hunt around your house to find as many different materials as possible. Can you tell us which objects you found these materials in? e.g. wooden – bench, chair, table / plastic – Lego blocks, cup, mixing bowl.
- ☐ **PSHCE task:** In PSHCE, we will be thinking about 'being me'. Draw a picture of you doing something you are good at! How does this make you feel?
- ☐ **History task:** In History, we will be finding out about Nelson Mandela and Rosa Parks. Can you do some research to find out about these very important people and why we remember them? You can look on the BBC Bitesize website for some help, as they have some information to read and a video to watch.
